

## Sample Policies for Michigan Merit Examination Graduation Requirement

<p>Frankenmuth High School 525 E. Genesee Frankenmuth, MI 48734</p> <p>Donald Zoller Principal</p>	<p>In our graduation requirements we have a simple statement "<i>Students must take all areas of the State Achievement Assessment.</i>" and " then a list of course work.</p> <p>We are using Achievement Assessment as the name may change but we will have a test of some sort.</p>
<p>Haslett High School</p> <p>Bart Wegenke Principal</p>	<p><u>State Standardized Testing Requirement</u></p> <p>In order to be promoted or meet graduation requirements for a diploma, all Haslett Public School students at the elementary, middle and high school levels are required to take all MEAP assessments and/or any other State or federal required assessments and are expected to put forth their best effort.</p> <p>Either during or prior to their junior year of high school, all students will need to have taken and achieved proficiency on all MEAP assessments and/or other State or federal required assessments.</p> <p><b>Note:</b> <i>If a student does not achieve proficiency on the MEAP, and/or other state or federal assessments, prior to their senior year testing window, the student will be expected to retake the state standardized assessment during their senior year, or the student and his parent(s)/guardian(s) must meet with the High School Principal or designee to discuss alternatives.</i></p>
<p>Charlotte High School 378 State Street Charlotte, MI 48813</p> <p>Lee Wheaton, Principal</p>	<p>Charlotte High School students must complete <u>either</u> the <b>Michigan Merit Exam</b> or <b>MI-ACCESS</b> tests when scheduled by the district, during the 11<sup>th</sup> grade year. Students who do not initially qualify for a diploma endorsement, in all areas tested, must retake those portions of the test a <b>second time</b>, unless excused by a current IEP. Participation in the State of Michigan Assessment program is a requirement for graduation from the Charlotte High School.</p>
<p>Peck Junior/Senior High School</p> <p>Willard W. Roles Principal</p>	<p>"In addition students will be required to take any necessary State testing such as MEAP, Michigan Merit Exam, etc as a graduation requirement."</p>
<p>Hastings High School</p> <p>Tim Johnston Principal</p>	<p>Hastings HS has required a student to participate in an " appropriate state testing (MEAP/ MI ACCESS)" to receive their diploma.</p>
