

MASC ADVISER OF THE YEAR

Application Form – 2006-2007

A Center Adviser of the Year for high school **and** middle school will be selected from each of the twelve centers of the MASC organization providing appropriate candidates are nominated. Recipients will be selected by the MASC Board of Delegates. (No Board member may participate in a Center's selection if his/her adviser is a candidate.) Recognition of the winners from each Center will take place at the State Conference. No adviser who has been honored with this award may be considered again until five (5) years after receiving the award. (A list of previous winners is available on the MASC/MAHS website.)

APPLICATION PROCESS (NEW FOR 2006-2007)

The candidate must be serving as an adviser for a MASC member school's student council group in order to be nominated.

The following documents must be included in the submitted application:

1. COVER PAGE

- a. Please complete the COVER PAGE document contained in this application. Missing information will disqualify the candidate.
- b. The Cover Page should be the **FIRST** page of the **stapled** application packet. Please **DO NOT** place applications in folders, bindings, or anything else "special" – a stapled packet is all we want. Creativity and presentation do not enhance the candidate's possibility of being honored with this award.

2. APPLICATION SHEETS

- a. Fill out the application sheets to the best of your ability or have the candidate complete them him/herself if this is not a surprise recommendation.
- b. Any incomplete or missing Application Sheets will result in the applicant being disqualified.

3. RECOMMENDATION FROM EXECUTIVE BOARD

- a. Each nominee must have a recommendation letter from his/her Student Council Executive Board (from one member of the Board is sufficient). The student(s) should write on why this adviser should be awarded the Adviser of the Year Award. Please include specific activities/projects/actions that make this adviser stand out above the rest. Be specific and provide evidence/examples.
- b. The recommendation letter is limited to one page and must be typed, double-spaced, and signed by at least one Executive Board member.

4. RECOMMENDATION FROM PRINCIPAL

- a. Each nominee must have a recommendation letter from his/her school principal. The Principal should write on why this adviser should be awarded the Adviser of the Year Award. Be specific and provide evidence/examples of the advisers' work/efforts/successes.
- b. The recommendation letter is limited to one page and must be typed, double-spaced, and signed by the Principal.

5. CANDIDATE'S LETTER

- a. Each nominee must compose a letter on the importance of student leadership in schools, and more importantly, the importance of student council groups in schools.
- b. The candidate's letter is limited to one page, typed, and must be signed.

6. DEADLINE

- a. All applications must be **POSTMARKED** by February 23, 2007
