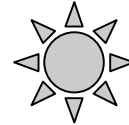
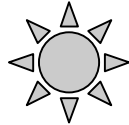
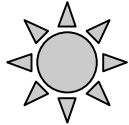


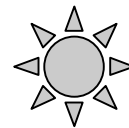
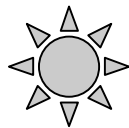
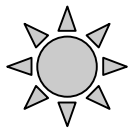
The Tonya Award

These outstanding donations were due in part to Tonya's efforts at making sure those who had something knew that they had a responsibility to help those who had less.



Each year, the Tonya Award will be given to one Student Council and one Honor Society Chapter that donates the greatest amount of money per enrolled student to the State Charities of the Year.

The 2006-2007 state charity is **Liberty Kids** (both MASC and MAHS have selected this charity). Donations must be postmarked by March 9, 2007 for a school to be considered for this award **and the check must be sent in with the MASC/MAHS Donation Form** that is on our website. One single check must be sent from the school, made out to **MASC or MAHS**.

The winning schools will be announced at the MASC/MAHS State Conference, March 24-26, 2007. There is no application for this award, it is determined by the Charity Donation Forms and checks received.
